This is George Perrieno's beautiful 1/4 scale Sopwith.

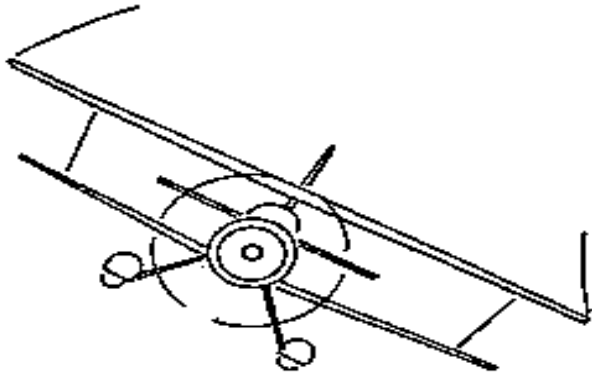
